## Transportation Services

### The Penquis Transportation Brokerage

The single source for scheduling MaineCare non-emergency transportation in Penobscot, Piscataquis & region 4 counties. The Brokerage schedules trips to medical appointments using vans, volunteers' cars, regional bus services and friends and family. Services are no cost and available to MaineCare members with two business days notice.

### Lynx Mobility Services

Provides public and social service transportation in agency vehicles. Transportation is also offered in private vehicles with volunteer drivers. All services are available by appointment only. 973-3695; 1-866-853-5969

### General Public (Mon-Fri 7:00 am-5:00 pm)

We serve each town in Penobscot and Piscataquis counties at least one day per week for a small fee. This can be used for any transit need. Cost varies depending on where the customer is going and where they live. 973-3695; 1-866-853-5969

### New Freedom (Mon-Fri 7:00 am-5:00 pm)

Customers who have a disability may use this for any transit needs including grocery shopping, visiting friends, volunteering, medical. It is \$2.50 per one way trip. 973-3695; 1-866-853-5969

### DHHS Low-income

Customers who fall within the DHHS guidelines (200% below poverty line) may use this for a variety of transportation needs. This program will cover up to two (2) trips per week at no cost. 1-866-853-5969, 973-3695

### Transportation Assistance Project

Provides mental health consumers with gasoline vouchers, mileage reimbursement, bus passes or full service transportation to a variety of non-MaineCare covered services. Certain restrictions apply. 973-3695; 1-866-853-5969

### Accessing Cancer Care

Provides transportation assistance (rides or reimbursement) for cancer treatment or support services for individuals living in Penobscot, Piscataquis or Knox county. There are no income requirements to be eligible. 973-3695; 1-866-853-5969
